Day 1 / RHODES (Mon.14th) FREE DAY

Day 2/ HALKI(Tues, 15th)

Day 7 KASOS/ (Sun. 20th) FREE DAY

Depart Halki 12:55. Arrive Kasos 17:40. Transfer to our hotel with its panoramic vista overlooking the picturesque port.

Day 8 /KASOS (Mon. 21st)

Fry: The port of Bouka with its colourful fishing boats and white-washed homes is a painter's delight! In the late afternoon, we will head off into the mountainous interior to the village of Panayia with its beautiful domed churches. **Dinner included.**

Day 9/ KASOS (Tues. 22nd)

Emborios:_This turquoise bay, with its little taverna on the water's edge surrounded by sun-bleached rocks, is a well-kept secret. **Lunch included**

Day 10/KASOS (Wed. 23rd)

Fry: The church of St Spyridon, overlooking the main harbour lined with white-washed houses and tavernas, makes a wonderful subject. **Afternoon review.**

Day 11/ KASOS (Thurs. 24th) FREE DAY

Depart Kasos 9.20am. Arrive Karpathos 10:30. With its' steep cliffs, deep ravines and forest-covered mountains. Karpathos is a magical island. Our hotel, overlooking the windswept beach, is the perfect place to chill out and paint.

Day 12/ KASOS (Fri. 25th)

Diafani with its little bay comprised of a handful of tavernas, is backdropped by majestic mountains. **In the late afternoon**, we will head to **Olympos**, to capture the afternoon light followed by a breathtaking sunset .





One of the most traditional villages in Greece, Olympos clings to the mountain side with striking windmills and a church with its stunning belltower. Many locals still wear their traditional, colourful embroided costumes.

Day 13/ KARPATHOS (Sat. 26th)

Boat trip to Saria Island and Tristomo: These picturesque bays, just a short boat trip from Diafani, are the perfect spot to paint and swim **.Lunch included.**

Day 14/ KARPATHOS (Sun. 27th)

Finiki: Passing through the village of Arkasa, we reach the small port and bay of Finiki, it's rocky hills dotted with white-washed houses. Sunday Grill At Kedros Taverna, with its fabulous atmosphere, is a popular spot with the locals. **Lunch included.**

Day 15/ KARPATHOS (Mon. 28th)

Diafani: This colourful port town with it's maze of little backstreets, makes a wonderful subject. **Late afternoon boat to Pigadi** for free time to explore the main town, the array of shops and to sample some of the local cuisine.

Day 16/ KARPATHOS (Tues. 29th)

Kyra Panagia and Achata Beach. The terra-cotta domed church, overlooking the little bay, is surrounded by bleached blonde rocks and fishing boats. Continuing on to the bay of Achata, we will stop for lunch and time to swim. **Lunch included.**

Day 17 /KARPATHOS (Wed. 30th)

Menetes is perched precariously on the top of a sheer cliff, overlooking the sea. From the church of Panagia, we have an amazing view of the whole village overlooking the main town of Pigadi in the distance.

Day 18/KARPATHOS (Thurs. 1st)

The garden of our hotel with its vibrant bougainvillea is a relaxing painting spot to finish up our artwork. Dinner included.
